



## NEW COVID-19 CVD REGISTRY



### Background and Significance:

COVID-19 is associated with adverse cardiovascular outcomes.
Patients with CVD or risk factors appear to be at higher risk for complications.

Understand the impact of COVID-19 on the development of cardiac conditions and complications in hospitalized patients.


